Nansana Hope is dedicated to improving the lives of extreme orphans in Nansana, Uganda and Rwandan genocide refugees in Kiboga, Uganda through access to medical care and education. The organization cares for 550 “extreme orphans” - children with no parents, uncles, aunts, or anyone else one generation older – who have lost their family members to wars and to the AIDS epidemic.



California YIMBY works with housing policy experts, elected officials, and grassroots organizations across California to craft and pass legislation at the state and local level that will help accelerate home building, solve the affordable housing crisis, and reduce climate pollution.
